# **HIGH SPEED BROADBAND**

63. Matthew Lloyd (Community Fibre Partnerships team for Openreach) gave a detailed presentation on community fibre and what is available within Highworth. The Government wants the UK fully fibred by 2033. Mr Lloyd confirmed the majority of cabinets in Highworth have been upgraded from adsl to vdsl plus fibre to cabinet.

A handful of houses have exchange only lines which means there is nothing to upgrade as the lines go direct from the exchange to the household. A way to upgrade would be to put in a new cabinet and have the households go through the cabinet allowing fibre or to have the fibre from the exchange to a node allowing fibre to the premises with a connection in the household. There is government funding available for this type of upgrade.
