



## Summary of Highworth Cycling and Walking survey Results



The Online Survey was carried out via the Highworth Town Council Website and Facebook page, with paper copies available from the Town Council Offices and Saturday Market.

460 people responded, with 236 people wanting to stay in touch

448 people supported improvements to cycling and walking provisions **(97%)**

223 people reported cycling once a week or more (48%)

327 people viewed lack of safe infrastructure as a barrier to cycling

447 people reported walking once a week or more **(97%)**

120 people viewed lack of safe infrastructure as a barrier to walking with top issues being width & maintenance of footpaths, safe crossings and dog waste

332 people would cycle from Highworth to Swindon if there was a safe cycle way **(72%)** with 289 of those intending to use it once a week or more

### Cycle route options prioritization:

40% to Swindon    32% Within Highworth    28% To Lechlade/Thames Path

242 People said they would use more cycle racks around town (52%)
