Exclusive Rights of Burials are no longer sold in perpetuity but only for a fixed period NOT exceeding ONE HUNDRED YEARS.

The fees shown exclude the charge for grave digging, which must be arranged by the Undertaker for full burials

Fees for interment are payable, in addition to the charge payable for the Grant of Exclusive Rights.

The Town Council makes no charge for any inscription either initially or subsequently made to those monuments, gravestones, tablets or kerb stones for which authority for the erection has been given.

The Town Council reserves unto itself the right to refuse permission for the erection of any monument, gravestone or tablet which it considers not suitable for a place dedicated for the purpose of interment. All memorials must be fitted by a BRAMM approved fitter and fitted to BS8415 Standards and comply to the NAMM Code of Working Practice.
