### Summary of additional comments

Most of the additional comments from the 20MPH survey strongly oppose introducing a 20 MPH Speed limit in Highworth. It was stated the current speed limit and parking in the busier areas should be enforced more, rather than changed.

The second most frequent comments were in relation to the experimental speed reduction at Redlands and that it should be brought back up to 40MPH.

There are also several suggestions for the High Street to become a one way, and for the inclusion of pinch points instead of reduced speed limits.

Some of the responses have also stated there should be designated crossing for children in the busier areas, Brewery Street and near the garage/Skate Park. With concerns raised that it is quite dangerous around school drop off and pick up time. A common theme was for the 20MPH to continue in place around the schools.

There were several responses suggesting speed bumps and that speed cameras would be more effective than a 20MPH speed limit. Suggestions that Park Avenue and Kings Avenue should be made one way or for permit holders only.
